




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MGM Park (Currently: Keesler Federal Park) Biloxi, MS

Date Partners provided full architectural services for this new baseball stadium. located in Biloxi off of Highway 90 near Beau Rivage Resort & Casino, The new-6,040-seat, 455,000 SF stadium is the home for the Biloxi Shuckers, a Minor League Baseball team affiliated with the Milwaukee Brewers. It can also host other large outdoor events such as concerts and festivals during the offseason. An elevated connector connects the ballpark to the casino and a 350-car. parking garage blends in with the stadium's design. The stadium layout is organized around the concourse level that wraps around the field and includes. concessions, a lounge and a team store. The majority of the seating is located. below the concourse level with 12 suites. situated above the concourse.

The property is located on tribal lands and the planning of this expansion was sensitive to this sacred location and designed not to cause harm to potential. artifacts on the site. The new hotel is four stories and has approximately 120. rooms, including doublewide and poolsuites. Guests have easy access to the rooftop pool and enjoy views of the golf. course and river. This addition also included a new lobby, offices, back of house and service areas for the entire. complex. The hotel adjoins the casino floor via the new Beale Street connector. which fronts the new B.B. King Blues. Club. The connector resembles the iconic Memphis Beale Street.

The project is an expansion of the existing OWA Destination Entertainment & Amusement Park development in Foley, AL New components include: a 200 key hotel of 6 stories, a new indoor water park of 65.000 square feet plus 1 story support spaces, new resort style pools for the hotel, new entry to amusement park and indoor water park with signage, a surf simulator, a wave 30,000 square foot wave pool; miscellaneous food and beverage venues including hotel. bar and grill, bar/grill at hotel pool, event stand for bands, sand beach at the wave pool and indoor water park, and extensive landscaping.

Dale Partners provided interior design services for the renovation of the hotel tower at the Wind Creek Casino and Hotel in Atmore, AL. The tower houses. 216 rooms and suites including typical double-bed and king rooms as well as ultra-king rooms and end suites. The renovation includes 12 typical floors. and top two floors featuring two bay suites with connecting queen rooms. The design services included all new flooring, wall vinyl, furnishings and fixtures with new draperies, lighting and artwork. The carpet in the casino and banquet spaces was also replaced. Casino broadloom wool/nylon carpet was replaced in eight phases to allow continuous operation of the gaming floor. The banquet carpet was replaced in three phases to minimize the impact to the meeting business.
